Shine Learning Mentor Job Responsibilities:

- Participates in Shine Professional Development Courses and Team Meetings
- Supports and manages the student's therapy and academic goals with the support of the Shine Clinical Therapy Team.
- Follows student centered learning plans developed in collaboration with Shine Clinical Therapists and School Teaching Team
- Monitor therapeutic and academic strategies to make sure they are performed correctly supporting development, bringing strategies that are not having the intended effect to the attention of the assigned Shine Clinical Therapist.
- Maintains records by documenting student's progress for use by the Shine Clinical Therapy team and School Teaching Team.
- Communicates students' progress to parents with daily journal/email communication
- Serves and protects Shine Child Development therapeutic practice by adhering to professional standards, policies and procedures
